## How to reach VUA

From Schiphol Airport 12 trains/hour run in 6 minutes to station Amsterdam Zuid (N.B. not Central Station); check <https://www.ns.nl>, buy tickets at the yellow/blue machines at Schiphol. A 10-minute walk in the direction from which the train came, you are at the VU.NU Building, de Boelelaan 1111.

Also, buses from Schiphol to VUmc bus stop run frequently. Bus tickets are sold in the bus.

Public transport stops around the VU/VUmc include tram 5, 24, 25 and busses 62 and 246 (Schiphol). Taxies are relative expensive in Amsterdam. Please book your own if needed.
